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

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

Conditions of Thematic Geospatial Information (IGT)



- GIS data is illustrated as database islands. They were not fully integrated yet.
- IGT producers concern only their own tasks, leading to map discrepancies
- One map policy is required to avoid map discrepancies by ensuring all thematic maps refer to the same standard and geospatial reference system




Scope of One Map Policy

- The main goal of One Map Policy is to guarantee the availability of accurate, accessible, and accountable geospatial information
- One Map Policy is a directive policy to support the production of geospatial information approved by the stakeholders and used nationally.



One Map Components





Ina-GeoPortal: instrument for sharing geospatial data/information among stakeholders (Ministries/Agencies) and Local Government











Province of Sumbar

- To avoid data duplication among stakeholders;
- Data Center in each network node is managed by Ministry/Agenncy and Local Government
- To integrate Geospatial Information managed by ministries/agencies which have function as Data Custodianship



- Members: government institutions, universities, and NGOs




- There are 12 working groups:

Mechanism of Developing One Map


Working group of IGT has agenda of regular coordination meeting

- Oceanography



























Closing Remarks
