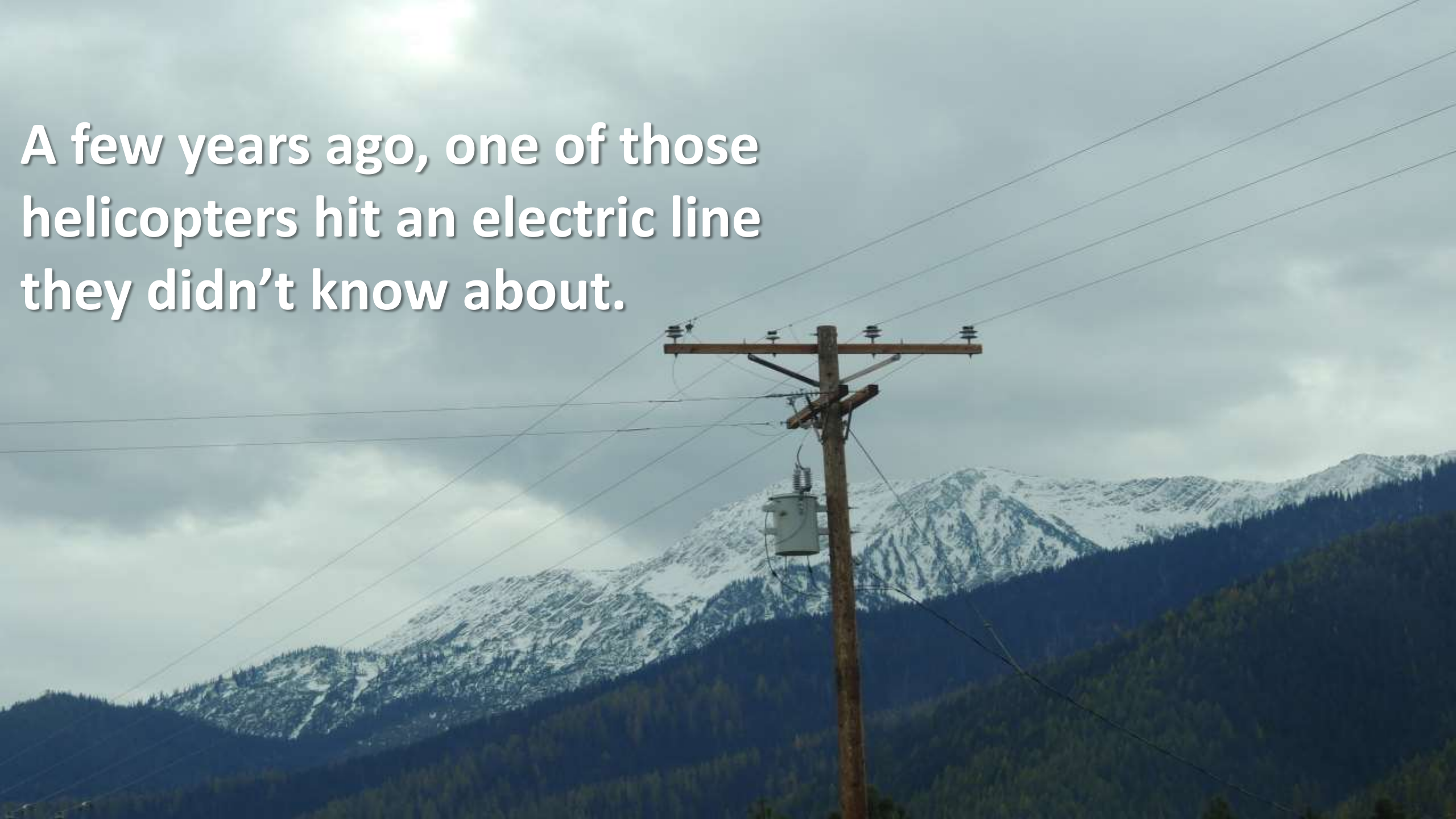

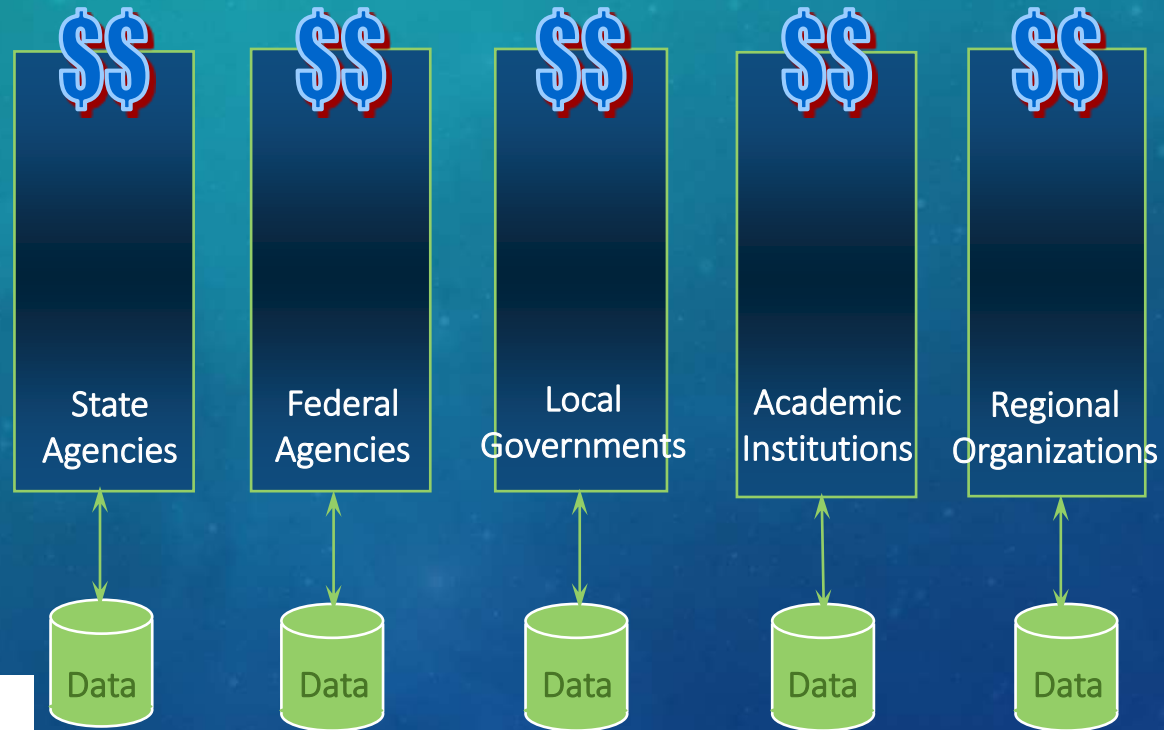
There is no formalized, authoritative structure that enables government organizations at all levels to collaborate to solve their shared problems.

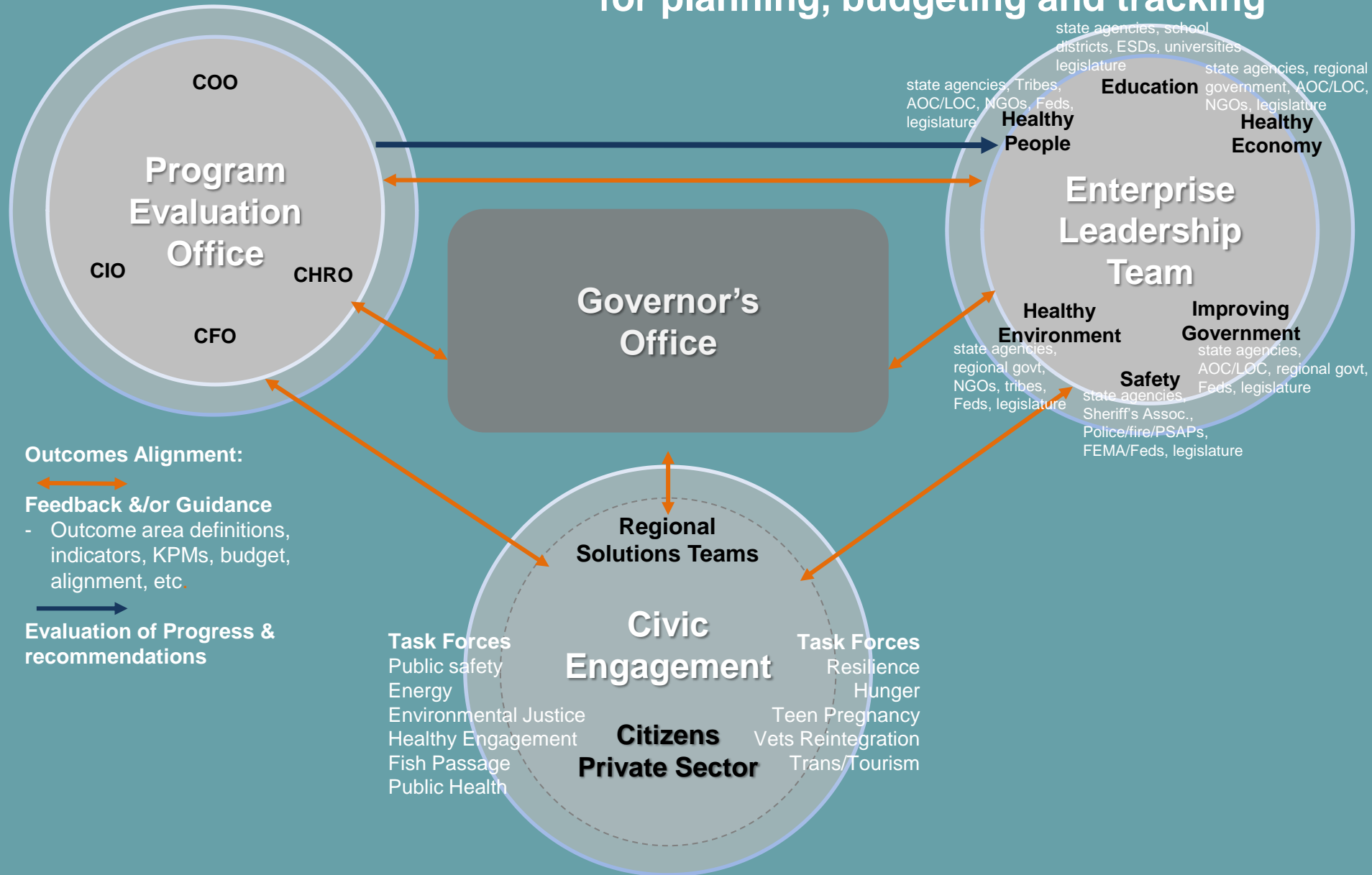

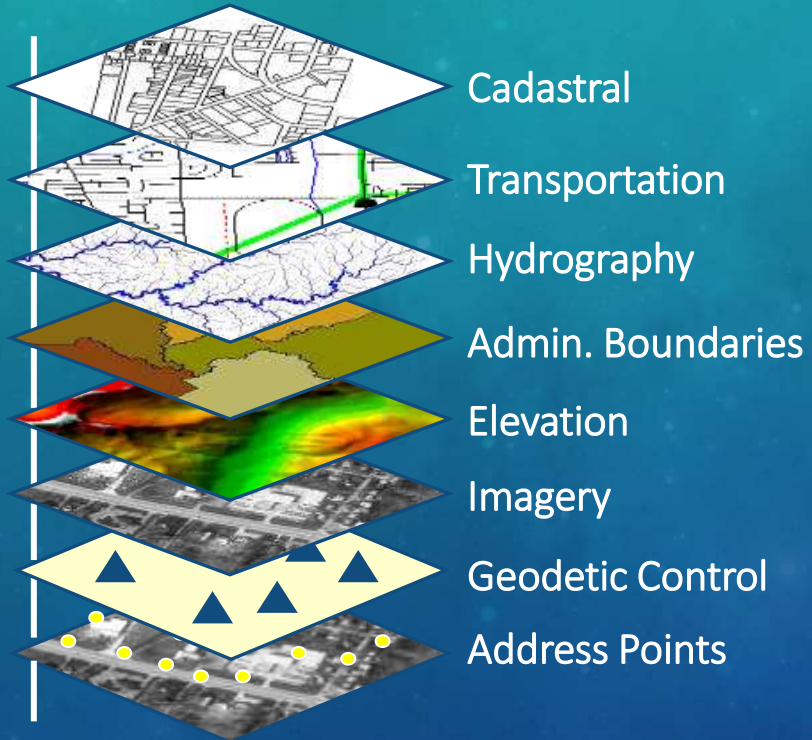


STATUTORY AUTHORIZATION ENACTED LAST YEAR  
FOR AN IMPROVED GIS GOVERNANCE MODEL

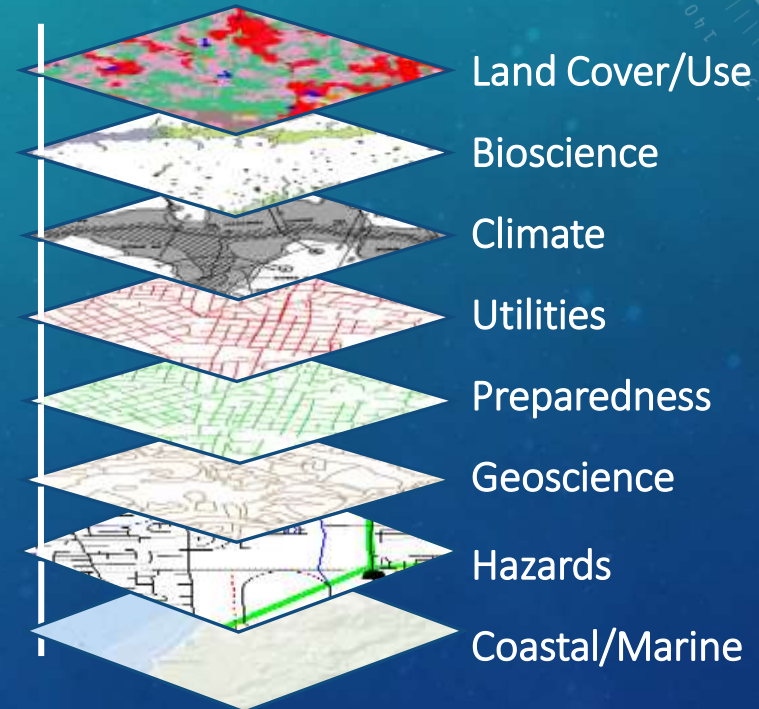


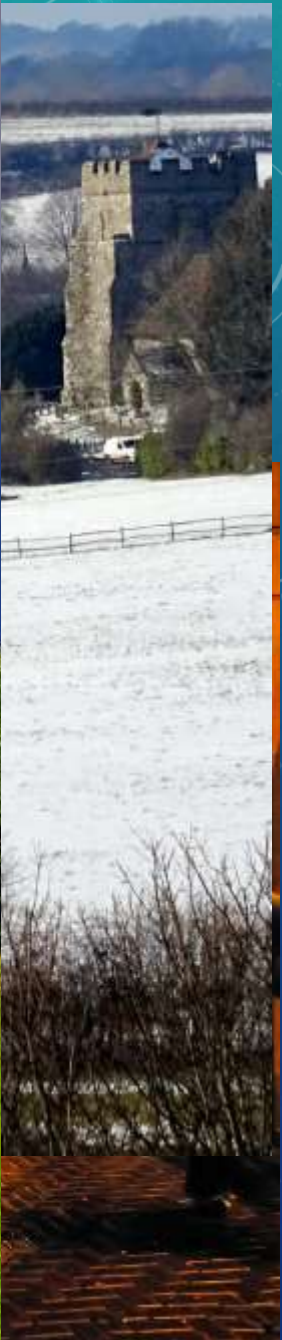
